It's home to most of the major world religions and some of the world's fastest growing cities.

Currently, there are no Christians among the Afshari. Pray that radio programming sharing Christ's love will soon be available in their dialect.

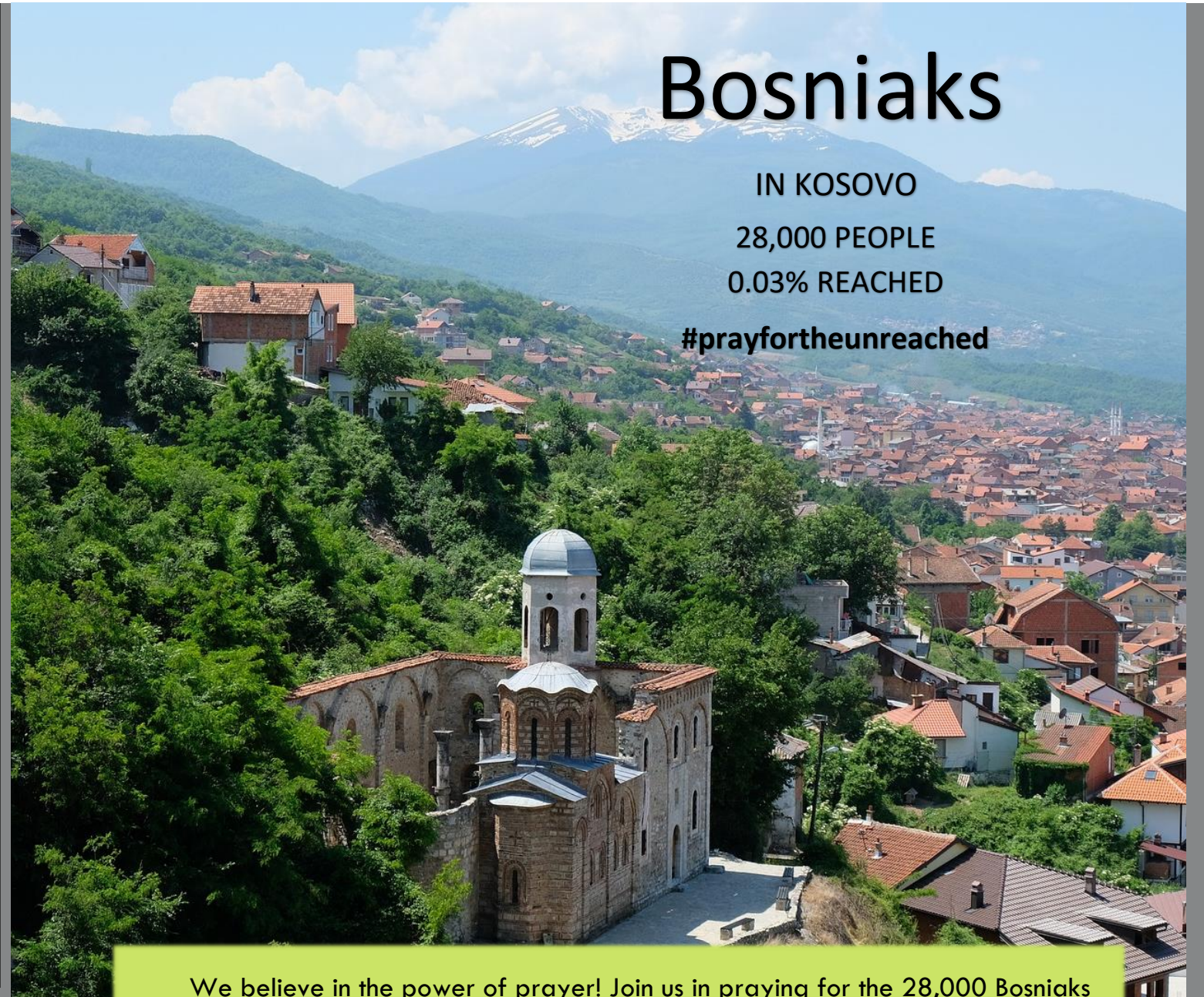

# Comorians

Comorians live on a group of volcanic islands also referred to as "perfume islands." This is because of their fragrant plant life which includes vanilla and ylang-ylang. Ngazidja Comorians are 419,000 in number, with Christians making up 0.6% of the population. Pray for medical teams to be sent to meet healthcare needs, such as the shortage of hospitals and doctors in this country. Pray also for boldness among the believers to share Christ with their own people.

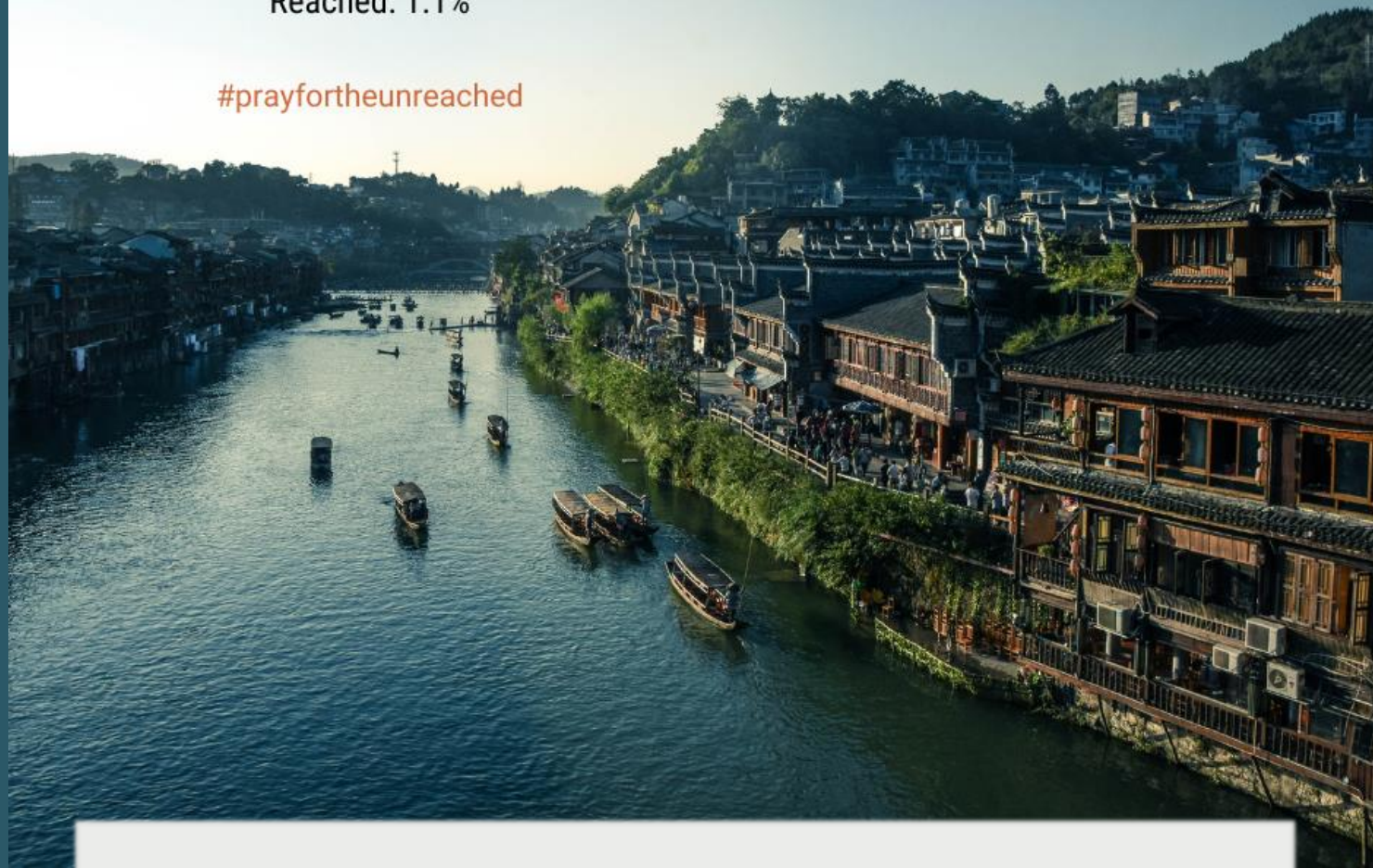


# Tujia in China

It is a symbol of the victory of good over evil. Of the 9,824,000 in the people group, 1.1% are Christians. Tunisia is the smallest country in North Africa, but its varied terrain is made up of beaches, mountains, rich farmland and desert. 0.12% reached

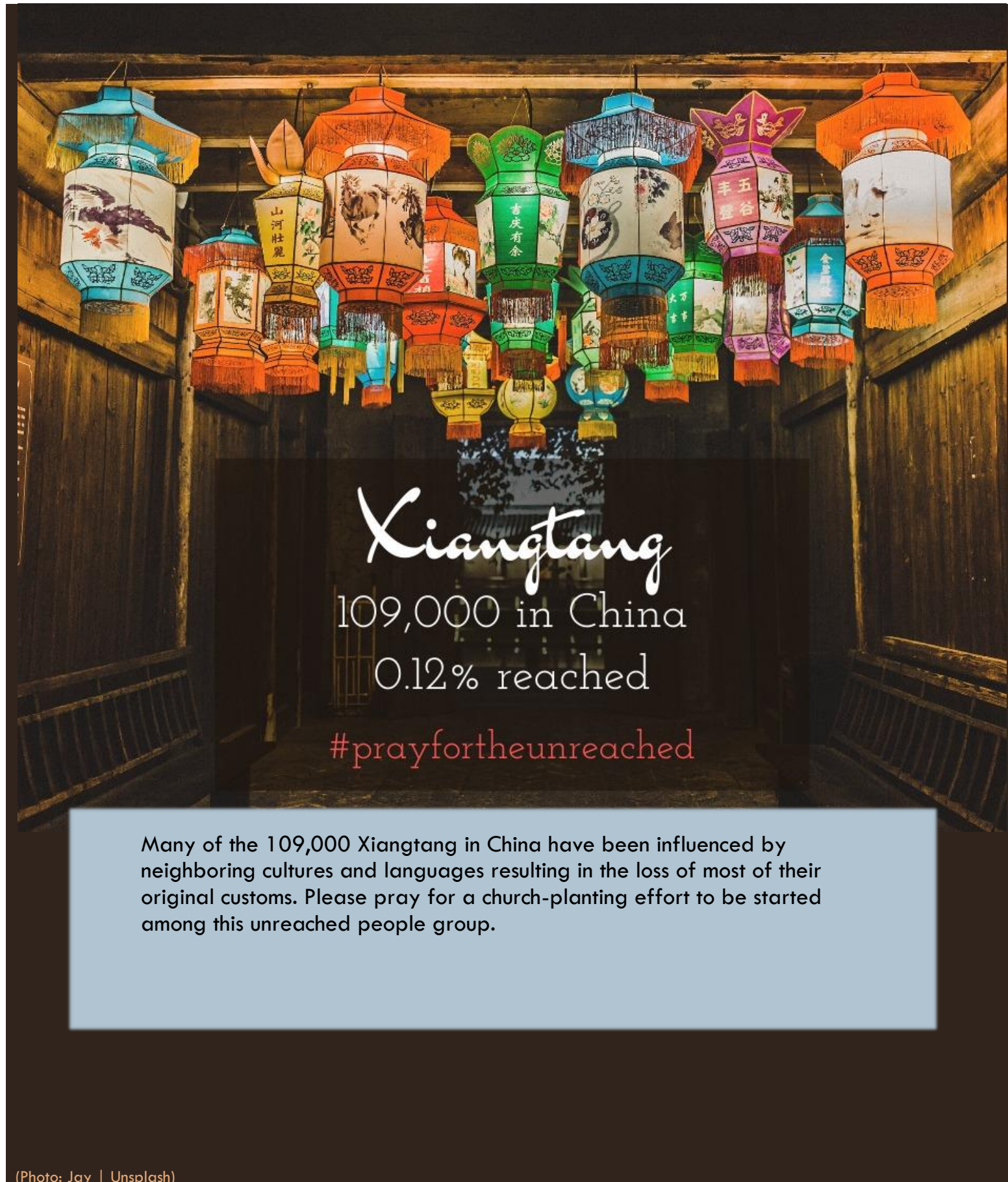
