

It extends from 10 to 40 degrees north latitude and stretches from North Africa through the Middle East and into Asia. Nearly 60 percent of the world's population lives here. It's home to most of the major world religions and some of the world's fastest growing cities.

Pray for the UNREACHED A prayer journey through the 10/40 window








Pray for the BHOI

in Nepal

Population: 149,000

Currently, there are no Christians in the Bhoi community in Nepal. We invite you to pray that this people group of 149,000 come to know of Jesus and His eternal love for them.





Superstition plays a strong role in the daily lives of the Bugis. Originally from Indonesia, they are a people group who are legendary warriors and excellent craftsmen. There is no Christian presence as yet within the 147,000 people of this group in Malaysia. Pray with us that they come to learn of their Creator.

Comorians

Population: 419,000 Reached: 0.6%

#PRAYFORTHEUNREACHED

Comorians live on a group of volcanic islands also referred to as "perfume islands." This is because of their fragrant plant life which includes vanilla and ylang-ylang. Ngazidja Comorians are 419,000 in number, with Christians making up 0.6% of the population. Pray for medical teams to be sent to meet healthcare needs, such as the shortage of hospitals and doctors in this country. Pray also for boldness among the believers to share Christ with their own people.



Hui in China

Population: 13,917,000 Reached: 0.01%

Most of the 13,917,000 Hui in China have yet to hear the gospel of Christ. Arab and Persian traders and Mongol soldiers make up the ancestry of present-day Hui. Pray for the few believers who make up only 0.01% of this people group. May they be encouraged to share their faith with their neighbors.



Pray for the Java Banyumasan who live in Central Java in Indonesia. Most of them make their living from farming and are comparatively advanced in this field. Only 2.5% of this people group know Jesus. Please pray that more of the 9,235,000 people in this group come to know Christ as their Savior.



Tujia in China

Population: 9,824,000 Reached: 1.1%



The Tujia are one of China's officially recognized nationalities. For this people group, the bull's eye refers to a Tujia legend and is a common motif in their embroidery. It is a symbol of the victory of good over evil. Of the 9,824,000 in the people group, 1.1% are Christians. Join us in praying that more in this large group learn of how Christ's sacrifice overcame all evil.



The life of the Temiar depends greatly on bamboo, which is used for food, receptacles, building houses, musical instruments, and weapons. There are about 32,000 Temiar in Malaysia, 7% of whom are Christians. Join us in praying for the believers working among this group as they meet people's physical and spiritual needs.

Population: 10,917,000 Reached: 0.22%

Tunisia is the smallest country in North Africa, but its varied terrain is made up of beaches, mountains, rich farmland and desert. More than half of the 10,917,000 Tunisian Arabs are below the age of 30 and are highly educated. Pray for the 0.22% of believers to remain strong in their faith and for the media outreach ministry that has generated an interest in some to learn more about Jesus in recent years.




